

Affordable Dental Care Resources in Richmond

If you are in need of dental care but cannot afford it, the city of Richmond offers several dental programs to help you access the care you need. The following programs are designed to provide no-cost or low-cost dental services to toddlers, children, and adults in Richmond.

1. Toddler Dental Clinic:

- Offered to children from birth to age 5.
- Services include risk assessment, dental screening, fluoride treatment, counselling, and referral.
- Contact: Richmond Public Health, 8100 Granville Ave., Richmond, BC

2. Children's Dental Treatment Clinic:

- Offered to children between the ages of 5-12 years old.
- All dental needs are met once-in-a-lifetime.
- Services provided at the UBC Faculty of Dentistry.

3. Adult Dental Treatment Clinic:

- Offered to eligible adults who reside in Richmond and have significant dental health needs.
- Services include cleaning, simple extraction, denture adjustments, and other basic dental work.
- Clinics are held 2-4 times a year. Pre-screening is required.
